

Martin McCarthy

Boastwain Martin McCarthy, 34 years a member of the United States Coast guard, who died at his home in Lanoka, Ocean county, will be buried Saturday afternoon with a detail of the Toms River station, which he commanded at the time of his death, in attendance. He was 58 years old.

Boatswain McCarthy suffered a stroke of paralysis last April. He was stricken again last Sunday and died Tuesday He entered the service in 1889 and served at Cedar Creek, Spermacetti Cove, Forked River and Toms River. Boatswain McCarthy had an excellant service record for faithful and efficient service and was highly respected by the members of his command and carried the complete confidence of his superiors. He commanded the Toms River station for about five years.

Captain John S. Cole commandant of the Fifth district Coast Guard, will attend the services.
