

All of the men on the McCulloch, 110, were taken off in lifeboats when the vessel began to sink after the collision, which occurred in a dense fog.

Preparations were under way tonight for an investigation of the collision by a board of inquiry appointed by Captain Robert Russell of the Tweifth naval district. The Governor was not damaged.

Johannsen was rescued by fellow sallors when he was missed after the men had taken to the lifeboats. He was found in his berth near the bow of the McCulloch. One lung had been punctured and several rihs and both legs were broken. He probably will die.

The 110 men from the McCulloch stood in their lifeboats with heads bared as the McCulloch went down. Some of the crew wept.
