

COAST GUARD LOSES LIFE; BOATS CRUSHED

LOUISVILLE, Ky. June 28.—Reference to United States coast guards records of forty years here today failed to show the death of a member in rescue work previous to that of John Munz, 27, Latonia.

Answering a call of distress from two youths, Coast guard crews tried the perilous feat of "jumping the dam" fearing they could not reach the youths in time by a safer course. Their boats were caught in the rapids below the dam and crushed against rocks.

A fisherman saved all guards except Munz.
