

Coastguardsman Missing As Vessel Overturns

OCEAN CITY, Md., Today — (INS)— One coast guardsman was believed drowned and two others were rescued when a coast guard vessel upset in the Atlantic Ocean yesterday while aiding a disabled fishing ship.

The missing man was identified as Charles E. Elliott, of Townsend, Va., who was soon to become eligible for retirement. The others were saved by hanging onto the coast guard ship.

The mishap occurred when the 36-foot coast guard vessel answered a distress call by the 90-foot trawler Southport which developed rudder trouble 500 yards off shore.
