

Ocean City Guardsman To Be Buried Today

OCEAN CITY, Md., April 10—(Special).—Funeral services will be held today at his home in Townsend, near Cape Charles, Va., for Chief Engineman Charles E. Elliott, coast guardsman from the Ocean City station, who was lost when a rescue boat capsized Friday. Interment will be there also.

The motor lifeboat from the Ocean City station was going to the aid of the distressed trawler City of Southport when it capsized.

The craft, of the "unsinkable" type(righted itself, and its other three occupants were saved.

Elliott's body was recovered yesterday in the Ocean City Inlet on the Maryland shore. Six of his mates from the U. S. Coast Guard Station here will act as pallbearers.
