Freak Mishap Kills Coast Guardsman

CLEVELAND, June 2 (A) — a Conrad J. Anderson, a 24-year-old scoast guardsman from Toledo, O., a died in Marine hospital today of injuries received in a freak accident six miles out in Lake Erie tast night.

Anderson, was standing on a libuoy after fixing its light and variation of the buoy tender, Tupelo. A sudden 35-mile wind shoved the buoy against the ship, squeezing Anderson between the two.

He suffered a crushing chest blow and internal injuries. A boatswain's mate, second class, Anderson was married and had one child.
